1<sup>st</sup> – Click on “Make A Payment”

2<sup>nd</sup> – Click on the type of payment you need to make


\*Please note the difference between a tax, estimated, and amended tax payment

3<sup>rd</sup> – Select the Form Type and Year to which the payment should be applied

4<sup>th</sup> – Confirm the information was filled out correctly, then press continue

5<sup>th</sup> – Fill out personal information based on what is recorded on the tax return to which the payment is applied and payment information

\*Bank information is required (not a credit card)
